# CONFIRMATION

## Updated SVHC list as per June 27, 2024

Dear Sir or Madam,

We would like to inform you that ECHA published an update on the candidate list of substances of very high concern (SVHC) dated **June 27, 2024**. In this connection, one substance was added to the candidate list.

We inform you that currently the materials E265, E630 and E2514 contain an SVHC-substance (2,2'-methylenebis(4-methyl-6-tert-butylphenol)) at a concentration above 0.1% (w/w).

For all other materials, we currently do NOT use any substances that were included in the original as well as the current candidate list of substances of very high concern.  
The presence of traces in concentrations BELOW the permissible limits for SVHC substances of 0.1% (w/w) cannot be ruled out.

We currently do NOT use any substances subject to authorization under Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation in our elastomeric and wear-resistant sheets.

We currently do NOT use any substances restricted under Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation.  
However, our black materials (except E9568 and P9541) contain as contaminations traces of substances, that **limit the use for applications** in articles, that are **NOT** placed on the market for supply to the general public, if they, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, come into direct as well as prolonged or short-term repetitive contact with the human skin or the oral cavity.
